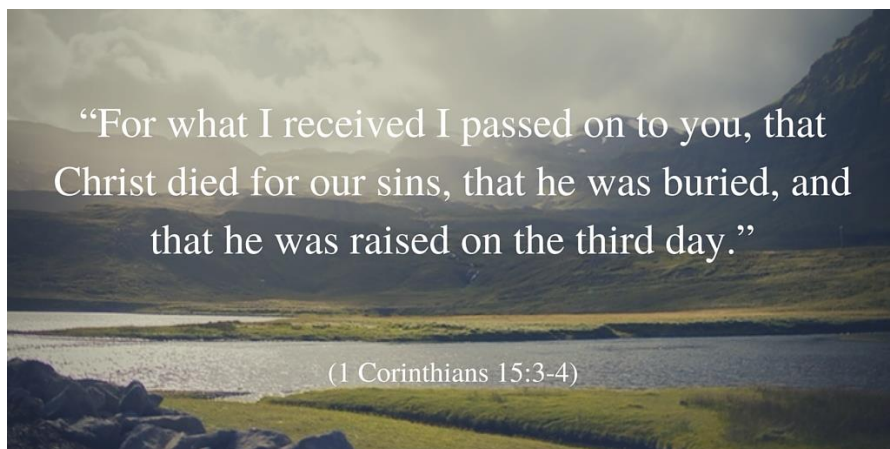

Six weeks with St Paul in Sunny Corinth!

Today is the fifth week of our mini-series based on St Paul's first letter to the church in Corinth considering the Gifts of the Spirit, Feb 17th Christ's resurrection (ch 15) and finally on Feb 24th his parting words and advice to his friends in Corinth (ch 16).

Christians Against Poverty (CAP) are running two free courses starting in March to help you manage your money. These are open to everyone and given by locally trained coaches:

- **CAP Money** is a three week course that teaches budgeting skills and a simple cash-based system. This course starts on Thursday 7 March at 7.30pm.
- **CAP Life Skills** is an eight week course which teaches practical money saving techniques, such as cooking on a budget, living healthily on less, and making money go further. Starting on 8 March, this course runs on Friday mornings and each week concludes with a free lunch.
