He will be visiting islands badly impacted by Typhoon Haiyan when winds reached up to 195mph. For the last five years Christian Aid has helped fishermen to rebuild their lives and avoid the need to gravitate towards the cities. He will have the privilege of hearing stories of courage, resilience and hope. To support Christian Aid's work financially and prayer see the information at the back of the church.
