

Jesus said, 'Peace Be With You', John 20:19

When questions and fears torment us we will often seek a safe place where we can hide. Similarly, the disciples sought refuge behind the locked doors of the upper room. However, it was empty of the one presence that would bring them relief and release.

When Jesus stood among them his first words were, '**Peace be with you!**' He would have been aware of their anxieties and fears and wanted to allay them at the first opportunity.

He could have said, 'Why did you deny me? I told you I would rise, so why didn't you believe me? You're supposed to be my followers and friends, the ones I've been closest to. Where is your faith?' Instead, he begins with positive words, '**Peace be with you**'.

How can we share and be that peace to others in our current situation?

During this coming week do we need to begin our conversations with the positive rather than the negative?

Where there is injury, your pardon Lord
And where there is doubt true faith in You

What kind of key opens a banana ? A monkey


Just took my 4 x 4 vehicle to a specialist. He said the answer is 16.




