Great News! Sunday morning worship begins again at SHMC.

The Stewards, in consultation with Tony, feel that this is the right time to resume meeting for worship on Sundays at 10.30am.

Things will be a little different as under current regulations there will be no singing and numbers are restricted to forty in any part of the building.

But the core reason for gathering remains the same: to offer worship, praise and thanksgiving to the living God who has revealed himself in Jesus.

Whether we are at SHMC or remain at home we are one church bound together in Christ.

How It Will Work This Sunday

We ask that everyone follows closely the guidelines of hand sanitising on arrival, refrains from all physical contact and practises good hygiene when coughing or sneezing. Anyone feeling unwell or with a raised temperature should not attend. We are required to keep a record of all who attend for 'track and trace'.

The lift will be operational and all chairs are distanced by one metre, although couples and family members can sit close together. Coffee will not be served after the Service.

There will be one gathering of forty adults in church which will include Tony leading the worship and watching Rev Dawn Saunders' pre-recorded sermon.

In the Church Hall there will be an overflow for up to another thirty adults where the whole Circuit Service will be broadcast. Children and youth will meet in other parts of the building and will not be joining together with the adult congregations.

If you would like to reserve a place in church please contact Sarah in the office before Friday at 4.00pm. Otherwise, just turn up on the day.

Once we have an idea of how many people have attended we will adjust as appropriate plans for future Sunday mornings.

Please observe any public instructions given by the stewards who are concerned with keeping everyone safe and well. As ever car parking is limited so we would ask that on-site parking is used by those who need it most.
